

Dear Parkinson's Movement Center Supporter,

In late 2021 Deb Colling followed her passion for helping people affected by Parkinson's disease (PD) live their best lives: she founded Parkinson's Movement Center (PMC), a 501c3 organization located in southeast Michigan. The PMC mission is: To help and support people whose lives are impacted by all Parkinson's Diseases, through vocalization, socialization, education, and community engagement all to better the quality of life through exercise, yoga, and movement.

PD affects over 1 million people in the United States, with 35,000 affected in Michigan alone. PD is a degenerative condition of the brain associated with motor symptoms (slow movement, tremor, rigidity and imbalance) and other non-motor complications including cognitive impairment, mental health disorders, sleep disorders and more. The Parkinson's Foundation now estimates that 90,000 people will be diagnosed yearly and that PD is becoming one of the fastest growing neurological conditions.

In a Parkinson's diagnosis, **exercise is medicine**! Research has proven that with exercise, we can slow the progression of PD and give back a quality of life that some thought they would never have again. Leveraging partnerships with local communities and local gyms, Deb, along with her team of certified instructors, have been teaching exercise classes under Parkinson's Movement Center since January 2022. In addition to addressing physical health, the classes build a community of support and friendship that helps to battle loneliness, depression and other symptoms of PD.

Future goals include opening a centrally located wellness center that will serve as a headquarters for PMC, and outfit with all the equipment necessary to meet the special needs of people with PD.

This year's event, *A Night to MOVE You*, which will be held on **Thursday October 19th at 6:00 p.m.** at **the San Marino Club**, promises to be an inspiring evening with a keynote speaker, a silent auction, a plated dinner, and an open bar.

The Gala will feature Tim Hague, the founder and executive director of U-Turn Parkinson's, an organization with a mission to empower people living with Parkinson's in their pursuit of wellness. Tim is a public speaker, educator, author, and advocate for people living with Parkinson's disease. At age 46, Hague was diagnosed with young onset Parkinson's disease. Three years later, he and his son, won the inaugural season of *The Amazing Race Canada*.
